- 1 BAR SOAP OF YOUR CHOICE. NATURAL IS BEST (I use goats milk soap) Cost of this soap: \$5-\$8
- 2 CUPS BORAX (Box about \$2.85)
- 1 CUP ARM & HAMMER SUPER WASHING SODA (Box about \$2.50)

GRATE THE BAR OF SOAP AND ADD TO A POT OF LOW BOILING WATER TO DISSOLVE IT, STIRRING CONTINUOUSLY.

USING A 5 GALLON BUCKET FILL THE BUCKET NOT QUITE TO TOP WITH WARM WATER. STIR CONSTANTLY WHILE ADDING THE DISSOLVED GRATED/MELTED SOAP, ALONG WITH THE BORAX AND SUPER WASHING SODA AND STIR UNTIL THOROUGHLY MIXED.

PUT LID ON BUCKET AND LET SIT OVERNIGHT.

NEXT DAY, TRANSFER ½ THE MIXTURE INTO ANOTHER 5 GALLON BUCKET, AND ADD MORE WATER TO EACH BUCKET AND STIR EACH BUCKET AND PUT LID ON AND LET IT SIT OVERNIGHT. NEXT DAY, STIR BOTH BUCKETS UP AGAIN AND START POURING INTO SMALLER BOTTLES USING A FUNNEL....NOW YOU HAVE 10 GALLONS OF LAUNDRY SOAP FOR LESS THAN \$10.00.
